To assist you in the discipline of returning to God a portion of what He has blessed you with, Cannon Church offers several methods of making your contribution. Please consider which one of these methods best fits your life-style.



Cash Contributions: Be sure to place your cash in an Offering Envelope and include your name on the outside so that we can make the proper entries into our accounting system for IRS regulations.



Check Contributions: Handwritten checks may be placed in the offering or mailed to the church. Make sure to write in the memo section of the check any special designation for the gift. It is not necessary to use an offering envelope when contributing by check. Please print legibly as offerings made by check will be scanned for deposit and electronically submitted to the bank.



On-line Contributions: Bank issued checks may be generated through your bank's on-line payment software. Please make sure to type the designation of the gift in the memo section. The mailing address for Cannon Church is 2424 Webb Gin House Road, Snellville, GA 30078.



Electronic Giving: Cannon offers a very convenient way to coordinate your giving with your payroll cycle. You can track your history of giving, setup recurring payments or submit a one-time gift. You can enroll by visiting www.cannonchurch.org and selecting the E-Giving icon.



Stock Gifts: Cannon accepts gifts of stocks through the North Georgia United Methodist Foundation. To transfer stock to the account of Cannon UMC (custodial bank-SunTrust), send stock to DTC 2971 Account # 11 04 122 1128976 (Cannon Church Account).



Payroll Deduction of Gifts: Larger corporate employers are now offering charitable giving through payroll deduction.
