The purple and pink candles represent hope, peace, joy, and love; four gifts from God through the gift of his Son. Tonight we light the Christ candle and celebrate the good news that the virgin conceived and bore a son, and they named him Emmanuel, which means “God with us” (Matthew 1:23).</p> <p>[The Christ candle is lit.]</p>
