

The Book that Brings Joy A few possible next steps

As you follow Jesus from this service of worship to the world that he loves, here are a few possible next steps in the light of the Scripture and sermon from Sunday, January 14.

READ and REFLECT

The Bible is a library; sixty-six books that tell a single story in six chapters. Those chapters and that story all lead us to Jesus, the one who brings joy. This Sunday, we explored the second chapter in the biblical story, THE FALL. Below is a list of readings to help you explore this chapter and theme in the week ahead:

- Sunday Genesis 3
- Monday Genesis 4
- Tuesday Genesis 6:5-8
- Wednesday Genesis 11:1-9
- Thursday Psalm 51
- Friday Romans 1:18-25
- Saturday Ephesians 2:1-10

According to the English writer G.K. Chesterton (1874-1936), "The Fall...is the only encouraging view of life. It holds...that we have misused a good world, and not merely been entrapped into a bad one. It refers evil back to the wrong use of the will, and thus declares that it can eventually be righted by the right use of the will."

As you read the passages above, reflect each day on these questions:

- In what way (or ways) do the people in this passage misuse God's gifts?
- What do I have in common with the people in this passage? How is this story also my story?
- How would this story be different if Jesus took the place of the central character(s)? Flip the story or passage on its head and rewrite it in your mind with Jesus perfectly loving others and God.

PRACTICE and PRAY

Practice the Examen, a daily "examination of consciousness" first popularized by Ignatius of Loyola (1491-1556). According to Pete Greig, the examen can take five minutes or one hour and unfolds in four simple steps:

- 1. **Replay** Think over your day like a movie replaying in your head. Notice what you are noticing. What made you happy? What made you anxious? What made you angry?
- 2. **Rejoice** Thank God for those things which are obvious. But also thank Him for non-obvious things which we sometimes forget random acts of kindness, being healthy, a positive song or meal. Relish and savor these moments in gratitude to God.
- 3. **Repent** Say sorry to God for moments that come into your mind as you review the day e.g., getting involved in gossip, reacting with a tone that was aggressive, lacking compassion in a situation, ignoring a need, not responding to a nudge. Receive His forgiveness afresh.
- 4. **Reboot** Make a decision in your heart to live for Jesus tomorrow and ask for grace to see His presence more clearly.








Cannon Youth are heading to Orlando for an awesome two days at Walt Disney World. We will leave on Friday February 16, and return Monday, February 19.






