

ROOTED

ROOTED

A few possible next steps

As we seek to be ROOTED, as Jesus was, in GOD through PRAYER, we invite you to join us each day this week as we Read, Reflect, Practice, and Pray.

Read

Since the early church was deeply connected with Jesus through prayer, we are reading the book of Acts in April and May. Most often referred to as The Acts of the Apostles, it is more accurately called The Acts of the Risen Lord by His Spirit through His Church. Read on and see why!

Tuesday: Acts 5:1-11

Wednesday: Acts 5:12-16

Thursday: Acts 5:17-42

Friday: Acts 6:1-7Saturday: Acts 6:8-15

Reflect

When you need to be inspired to dwell deeply with Jesus and others through prayer, read and reflect on any or all of the following observations about the Lord's Prayer:

After more than twenty-five years in pastoral ministry, twenty of them teaching on prayer, I have come to the conclusion that most people's biggest problem with prayer is God. They envisage him scowling, perpetually disapproving, invariably disappointed and needing to be placated or persuaded in prayer. If that's how you picture God, I really don't blame you for trying to avoid his gaze! But Jesus says something completely different.

(Pete Greig, How to Pray, p.53)

All who adore Him must adore Him in the Spirit of truth. And day and night let us direct praises and prayers to Him, saying, "Our Father, Who art in heaven.". (Francis of Assisi)

This God whom we worship, even while being our Father, is also the God of the heavens, the inescapable one, the profound mystery that we are too small to even begin to conceive. And yet, this one loves us as a Father! (Justo Gonzalez, Teach Us To Pray, p.59)

Practice

For most of Christian history, believers have paused three times a day to pray the Lord's Prayer. During the months of April and May, we're encouraging everyone to adopt this ancient practice at whatever times work best for you. The key is to make it a habit. Set your alarm as a gentle reminder to pause and pray:

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, the power, and the glory, forever. Amen.

Pray

In addition to praying the Lord's Prayer three times per day, we're inviting everyone to experiment with one-sentence prayers; simple, brief prayers drawn from Scripture that help us re-center our hearts on God. This week, consider using, "Our Father in heaven..." (Matthew 6:9) as your one-sentence prayer. Repeat it, paraphrase it, and expand on it (briefly) throughout the day; not as a way to ask anything from God, but instead as a way to be present to God. For example, the words could be repeated in any or all of the following ways:

Our father in heaven
Our heavenly father
Our father most high
Our father most near
Our father all around us
Our father with and for me
Our father with and for all

You get the point!
