

ROOTED

ROOTED

A few possible next steps

As we seek to be ROOTED, as Jesus was, in GOD through PRAYER, we invite you to join us each day this week as we Read, Reflect, Practice, and Pray.

Read

Since the early church was deeply connected with Jesus through prayer, we are reading the book of Acts in April and May. Most often referred to as The Acts of the Apostles, it is more accurately called The Acts of the Risen Lord by His Spirit through His Church. Read on and see why!

Practice

For most of Christian history, believers have paused three times a day to pray the Lord's Prayer. During the months of April and May, we're encouraging everyone to adopt this ancient practice at whatever times work best for you. The key is to make it a habit. Set your alarm as a gentle reminder to pause and pray:

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, the power, and the glory, forever. Amen.

Reflect

When you need to be inspired to dwell deeply with Jesus and others through prayer, read and reflect on any or all of the following observations about the Lord's Prayer:

Every part of our lives is better when we live "not my and mine but Thy and Thine." (Adam Hamilton, The Lord's Prayer)

What we are calling for is not so much a different place as a different order. It is a new order in which, as Jesus promises, those who have been last will be first, those who have been oppressed will be free, and where instead of injustice and exploitation there will now be justice, freedom, and love. (Justo Gonzalez, Teach Us to Pray)

We can only pray this prayer for the church if we are prepared to mean: make us Kingdom bearers! Make us a community of healed healers; make us a retuned orchestra to play the Kingdom music until the world takes up the song. (N.T. Wright, The Lord and His Prayer)

Pray

In addition to praying the Lord's Prayer three times per day, we're inviting everyone to experiment with one-sentence prayers; simple, brief prayers drawn from Scripture that help us re-center our hearts on God. This week, consider using, "Hallowed be thy name", "Thy kingdom come" or "Thy will be done" as your one-sentence prayer. Repeat it, paraphrase it, and expand on it (briefly) throughout the day. As you do, remember that this is not a prayer of resignation. Instead, it is a rebellion against the disorder of the world and of our own hearts.




TROOP 506 AMERICAN FLAG RETIREMENT






