### ROOTED

#### A few possible next steps

As we seek to be ROOTED, as Jesus was, in GOD through PRAYER, we invite you to join us each day this week as we Read, Reflect, Practice, and Pray.

Read

Since the early church was deeply connected with Jesus through prayer, we are reading the book of Acts in April and May. Most often referred to as The Acts of the Apostles, it is more accurately called The Acts of the Risen Lord by His Spirit through His Church. Read on and see why!

#### Reflect

When you need to be inspired to dwell deeply with Jesus and others through prayer, read and reflect on any or all of the following observations about the Lord's Prayer:

When we ask for "our daily bread" we are not asking only for ourselves, nor even for our sisters and brothers in the church, but for the entire human race, even those who may not know our Lord. Even though they do not know it, we are also asking that they may have their daily bread. (Justo Gonzalez, Teach us to Pray)

Those who have more than enough become the answer to the prayers of those who are lacking. We become the angels, the miracle workers, and the source of manna from God. (Adam Hamilton, The Lord's Prayer)

The bread that you hoard belongs to the poor; the cape that you hide in your trunk belongs to the naked; the shoes that rot in your home belonged to those who have no shoes. (Basil of Caesarea, 330-379 AD)

#### Practice

For most of Christian history, believers have paused three times a day to pray the Lord's Prayer. During the months of April and May, we're encouraging everyone to adopt this ancient practice at whatever times work best for you. The key is to make it a habit. Set your alarm as a gentle reminder to pause and pray:

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, the power, and the glory, forever. Amen.

#### Pray

In addition to praying the Lord's Prayer three times per day, we're inviting everyone to experiment with one-sentence prayers; simple, brief prayers drawn from Scripture that help us re-center our hearts on God. This week, consider using, "Give us this day our daily bread" as your one-sentence prayer. Repeat it, paraphrase it, and expand on it (briefly) throughout the day. As you do, remember that this is a prayer not just for us, but for others and for all. Likewise, this isn't just a prayer for our physical bread, it is also a prayer for our spiritual food. Use these words to pray daily and constantly that God would feed our bodies and our souls.


#### PRAYER SHAWL MEETING

### May 5 - Youth Center






