

#### Better Than Jesus? - A few possible next steps

As a way to explore the promise of the Spirit in our chaos today, we invite you to pause briefly each day to read, reflect, practice, and pray.

READ	As we celebrate Easter (the resurrection of Jesus) and get ready for Pentecost (the gift of the Holy Spirit), we invite you to read the New Testament book of Acts. Most often referred to as "The Acts of the Apostles", this thrilling adventure could more accurately be called "The Acts of the Risen Lord by His Spirit Through His Church."			
	Monday: Acts 23:23-24:27 Tuesday: Acts 25:1-22 Wednesday: Acts 25:23-26:32 Thursday: Acts 27:1-38 Friday: Acts 27:39-28:15 Saturday: Acts 28:16-31 Sunday: Catch up on your reading!			
REFLECT	As you read the passages listed above, take a few moments to reflect on any or all of the following questions:			
	In this passage, how does the risen Lord speak or act through the apostles (or others) with the help of the Spirit? How do people respond?			
	What word, image or phrase speaks most powerfully to you? Does it comfort you, confront you, challenge or inspire you?			
PRACTICE	Just as Elijah had to listen for "a sound of sheer silence" (1 Kings 19:12), so we need to listen if we would hear God. Toward that end, be radically counter -cultural and set aside five minutes of silence each day this week. Sit comfortably, but attentively. Breathe deeply. Just listen. Don't talk out loud or in your head. This will be hard, but don't give up. If we want to hear God, we must practice listening			
PRAY	After reading and reflecting on the passages above, offer yourself and your day to the Spirit with this prayer:			
	Come, Holy Spirit. Come fill me with your fruit; the fruit of love, joy, and peace; the fruit of patience, kindness, and goodness; the fruit of faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. The world wants to fill me with worry, stress, and fear. Please fill me instead with the fruit of your love. And please do it quickly! Through Jesus Christ, our crucified, risen, reigning Lord. Amen.


