Better Than Jesus? - A few possible next steps

As a way to explore the promise of the Spirit in our chaos today, we invite you to pause briefly each day to read, reflect, practice, and pray.

READ

As we celebrate Pentecost (the gift of the Holy Spirit), we invite you to read selected passages from 1 Corinthians, a letter Paul wrote to an exciting, dynamic, but deeply divided church. As you will see, one of the sources of their division was confusion about the person and work of the Holy Spirit. Paul preaches the gospel, the good news about Jesus, to help them mature and become more fully one through the gift and gifts of the Holy Spirit.

Monday: 1 Corinthians 1:10-31

Tuesday: 1 Corinthians 2 Wednesday: 1 Corinthians 3 Thursday: 1 Corinthians 12 Friday: 1 Corinthians 13 Saturday: 1 Corinthians 14

Sunday: Catch up on your reading!

REFLECT

As you read the passages listed above, take a few moments to reflect on either or both of the following questions:

In this passage, what were the causes of division in the church?

How does Paul speak of their unity in Christ as both a gift and a calling; something given by God, which they must receive and actively live?

PRACTICE

Pray daily for the unity of the church; Protestant, Catholic, and Orthodox.

PRAY

After reading and reflecting on the passages above, offer yourself and your day to the Spirit:

Come, Holy Spirit. Come fill me with your fruit; the fruit of love, joy, and peace; the fruit of patience, kindness, and goodness; the fruit of faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. The world wants to fill me with worry, stress, and fear. Please fill me instead with the fruit of our love. And please do it quickly! Through Jesus Christ, our crucified, risen, reigning Lord. Amen.






