THE LOVE THAT IS GOD

A few possible next steps

Do you want to spend the summer with the God who is love by immersing yourself in the love that is God? Toward that restful end, take time each day to read, reflect, practice, and pray.

READ

This week we will read Jesus' final teaching in the Gospel of John. As Frederick Bauerschmidt has written, "it is through [the] Spirit that ongoing friendship with the risen Jesus is possible, not just for the disciples of his day but for all Christians down through history" (*The Love That Is God*, p.53). Not surprisingly, therefore, Jesus teaches his disciples about the person and work of the Spirit in the same section of John's gospel where he calls them his friends. As you read these chapters, pay attention to the ways that Jesus identifies the indwelling Spirit with his presence in the lives of his followers and friends.

Monday: John 14:1-14

Tuesday: John 14:15-31

Wednesday: John 15:1-17

Thursday: John 15:18-27

Friday: John 16:1-15

Saturday: John 16:16-33

Sunday: Catch up on your reading!

REFLECT

In addition to the passages above, take a moment to reflect on any or all of these observations from *The Love That Is God* by Frederick Bauerschmidt:

Friendship entails conversation. And if we are called to friendship with God through the risen Jesus, then we are called to a life of conversation with God. Which is another way of saying that we are called to pray. (pp.59-60)

If friendship with Jesus constitutes friendship with God, then by inviting sinners to sit with him and dine, Jesus seeks to reconcile them with God, no matter how scandalous that practice might be. (p.64)

Because God's love is not drawn to our goodness but creates our goodness, because it is active and not reactive, the Spirit can transform God's enemies into God's friends. (p.69)

PRACTICE

Since there is a difference between "dining" and "eating", find a way to *dine*, to share a table with family or friends at least once this week. Take time to enjoy each other, enjoy the meal, and enjoy the conversation. Such meals, according to Jesus, are a preview of heaven!

PRAY

Before and after reading the passages assigned to each day, pray simply and repeatedly, "Come, Holy Spirit. Please deepen my friendship with Jesus this week."

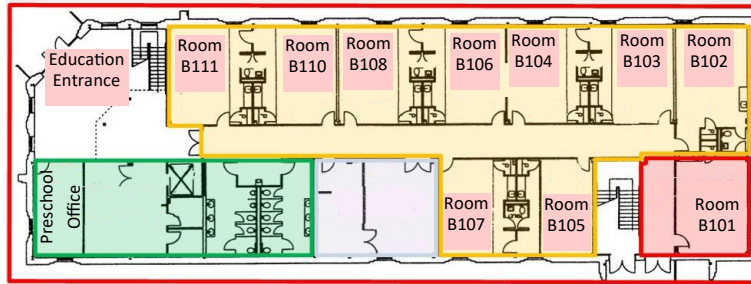

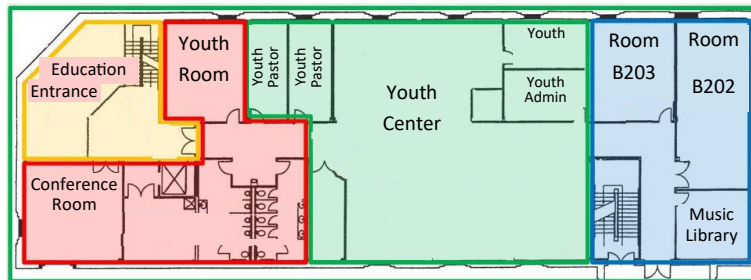

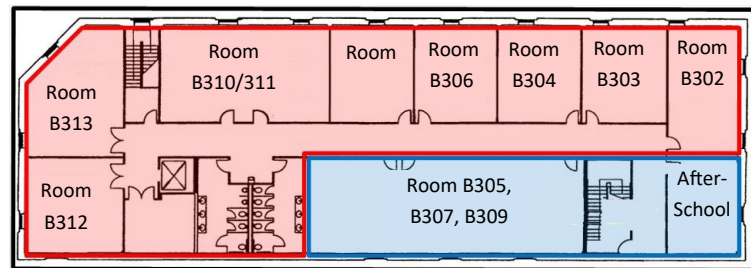
Building B / Education Building



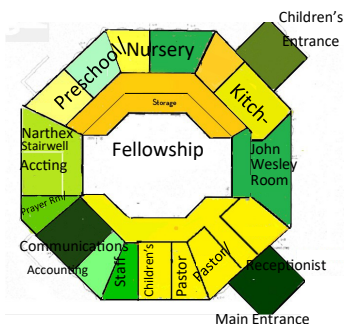
1st Floor



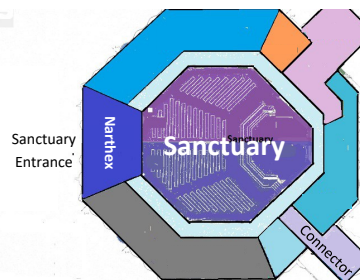
2nd Floor
