THE LOVE THAT IS GOD A few possible next steps

Do you want to spend the summer with the God who is love by immersing yourself in the love that is God? If you do, we recommend pausing each day to read, reflect, practice, and pray.

	practice, and pray.				
READ	This week we will read the book of the prophet Micah, who lived eight centuries before the birth of Christ. In his day, the kingdom of Judah was threatened by Assyria, which would eventually conquer the kingdom of Samaria (the northern portion of God's divided people). These were perilous times, both politically and spiritually. In that context, Micah delivered oracles of doom (chapters 1-3) and poems of hope (chapters 4-7), both of which were based on God's love for his people and his loving demand that the rich and powerful stop worshipping idols, abusing their power, exploiting their neighbors, and ignoring the poor. In other words, if we want to love God, we must love our neighbors. If we don't love our neighbors, we don't really love God!

REFLECT	In addition to the passages above, take a moment to reflect on any or all of the following observations from <i>The Love That Is God</i> by Frederick Bauerschmidt:				
	To claim to love God without engaging in the difficult task of loving those whom I encounter in my everyday life is to engage in a deadly, deceptive fantasy; I am lying to others and to myself. (p.77)				
	In the calculation of God, I somehow owe everything to the needy neighbor from whom I have received nothing. (p.79)				
	Living at peace with God and each other is what people most deeply desire; it is inherently attractive because it is the kind of life for which we were created. (p.85)				
PRACTICE	Give someone the gift of attention this week. Be quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to judge. Be curious and generous with your time and attention. Trust and love others (at least <i>one</i> other) <i>before</i> they have a chance to love and trust you.				
PRAY	Pause briefly each day to pray this prayer attributed to Saint Francis of Assisi (c.1181-1226):				
	Lord, make me an instrument of your peace: where there is hatred, let me sow love; where there is injury, pardon; where there is doubt, faith; where there is despair, hope; where there is darkness, light; where there is sadness, joy.	O divine Master, grant that I may not so much seek to be consoled as to console, to be understood as to understand, to be loved as to love. For it is in giving that we receive, it is in pardoning that we are pardoned, and it is in dying that we are born to eternal life.
