

But I Say To You A few possible next steps

Would you like to find happiness by following Jesus? Take time each day to read, reflect, practice, and pray!

READ

This fall we are reading and reflecting on the speeches of Jesus in the Gospel of Matthew. As we will discover, these speeches have changed, and are changing, the world by inviting us to live toward the world as it will be. In other words, they both challenge and help us to be the change God has promised to bring when Christ comes again. Three weeks ago we read the Sermon on the Mount in one week. We are now slowing down to read the Sermon at a slower, more meditative pace.

Monday: Matthew 7:1-11 Tuesday: Matthew 7:12

Wednesday: Matthew 7:13-14 Thursday: Matthew 7:15-20 Friday: Matthew 7:21-23 Saturday: Matthew 7:24-29

Sunday: Catch up on your reading!

REFLECT

The Sermon on the Mount is the best known, most often quoted, and most widely ignored teaching of Jesus. After reading the passages above, take a moment to reflect on any or all of the following questions.

How is this teaching counter-intuitive (not what we expect) and/or counter-cultural (not how we live)?

What do you find most challenging or disturbing in this passage?

What's most exciting?

PRACTICE

Here at Cannon we're committed to four basic steps in our discipleship to Jesus: gathering for worship, growing in love, giving to bless, and going to serve. This week, if you haven't done so already, give to bless by signing up to run, walk or pray during the Relay for Love on Thursday, September 11! See our bulletin for more information.

PRAY

Before (and after!) reading the Scriptures listed above, take a moment to pray this prayer:

Lord Jesus, you are not a dead founder, but our living Lord. Be our Priest to forgive us, our Prophet to teach us, our King to rule us, and our Shepherd to guide us; for the good of our neighbors, the blessing of our enemies, and the glory of our God. Amen!
