All Sinners Sunday

A few possible next steps

As we delight in the God who exalts over us with loud singing (Zephaniah 3:17), we invite you to pause briefly each day to read, reflect, practice, and pray.

READ

Since most people associate the Old Testament with the anger of God, this week we will read about his love as it was revealed long before Jesus.

Monday: Exodus 34:1-9

Tuesday: Jeremiah 31:1-6

Wednesday: Lamentations 3:19-24

Thursday: Hosea 11:1-9

Friday: Isaiah 43:1-7

Saturday: Psalm 103

Sunday: Catch up on your reading!

REFLECT

After reading the passage for the day, take a moment to reflect on any or all of the following questions:

- ♦ What do I see when I read this passage? What images come to mind?
- ♦ What do I feel when I read this passage? What emotions does it evoke in me?
- ♦ What questions do I ask when I read this passage? What is confusing, unclear, or frustrating?
- ♦ How can I turn this passage into a prayer for others and/or myself?

PRACTICE

Pay attention to bumper stickers this week. In particular, pay attention to *political* bumper stickers this week. Once or twice this week, pray for someone whose bumper sticker reflects the other side of our divide. Without sarcasm, bitterness or rage, pray that God's love would surprise them sometime this week.

PRAY

Before reading the Scriptures above, pause to offer this traditional prayer back to God:

Almighty God, to you all hearts are open, all desires known, and from you no secrets are hidden. Cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of your Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love you and worthily magnify your holy Name through Christ our Lord. Amen.

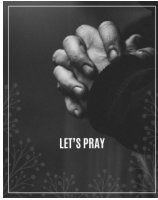

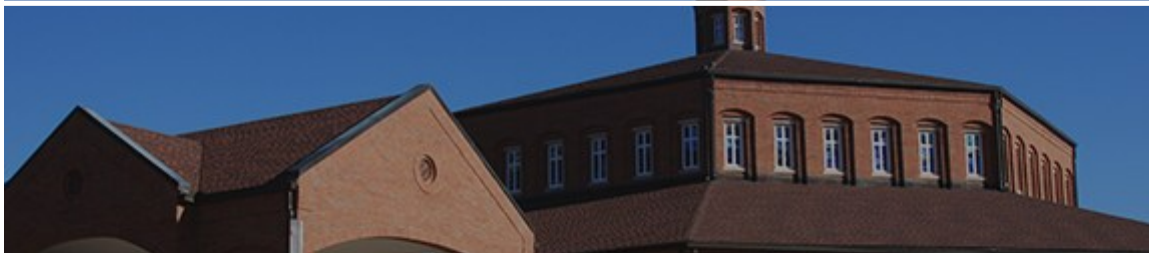
