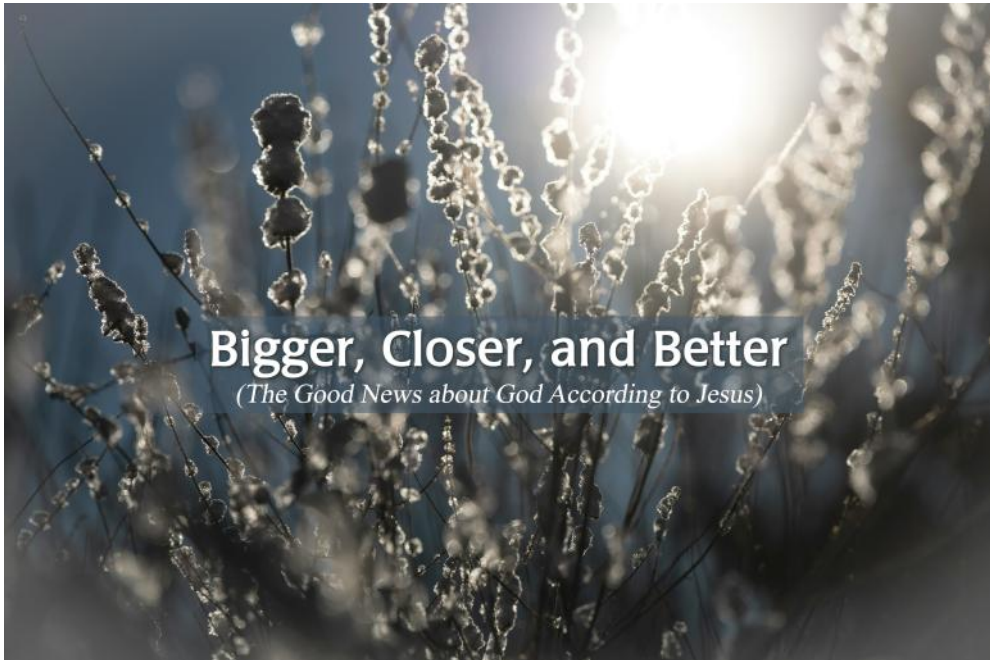

Bigger, Closer, and Better

A few possible next steps

Would you like to experience “the gospel of God” (Mark 1:14), the good news about God according to Jesus? Pause briefly each day to read, reflect, practice, and pray!

READ

The first half of Mark’s gospel is dominated by the theme of Jesus’ authority. As the Messiah and Son of God, Jesus speaks and acts with the power of God, but that power is always in the service of others. As Jason Meyer has observed, “His unrivaled power and wisdom leave one with a sense of awe, but the portrayal of his unrivaled heart touches us even more deeply.” This week we’ll read passages that reveal Jesus’ power and portray his heart.

Monday: Mark 1:21-28

Tuesday: Mark 1:40-48

Wednesday: Mark 1:1-12

Thursday: Mark 3:1-6

Friday: Mark 4:35-41

Saturday: Mark 5:1-20

Sunday: Catch up on your reading!

REFLECT

After reading the passages listed above, take a few moments to reflect on any of all of the following questions:

- How does this passage reveal Jesus’ power? What kind of authority does he exercise or claim for the benefit of others?
- How does this passage portray Jesus’ heart? What actions and/or words reveal his compassion?
- How am I like and unlike the people in this passage? What needs do I share with them? What prayers do I pray with them?

PRACTICE

If you haven’t done so already, make daily Bible reading a new habit this year. It doesn’t have to be complicated or take a lot of time. Just read the passages assigned to each day. Use of the questions for reflection listed above to help you take note of any words, images, or phrases that speak personally to you.

PRAY

Turn the Scriptures into prayer by using the words that the disciples and others speak to Jesus into the words that you speak to him now.
